Many of you take the time to read to your child at home. This is so important for bonding and for modeling reading. Bedtime stories are a wonderful way to wind down from the day and a great routine to get into. Children learn to predict, ask questions, and develop vocabulary too.

Music is another way to teach and bond with your child. The children have so much fun with music. Having a keyboard is great- it is why the children are welcome to play the piano at school. Music weaves its way into many areas of learning. There are songs to help with transitions (like clean up songs) and songs to learn about our community (fire truck song) and songs with math (5 little ducks) or even days of the week songs.
